- School or work supplies

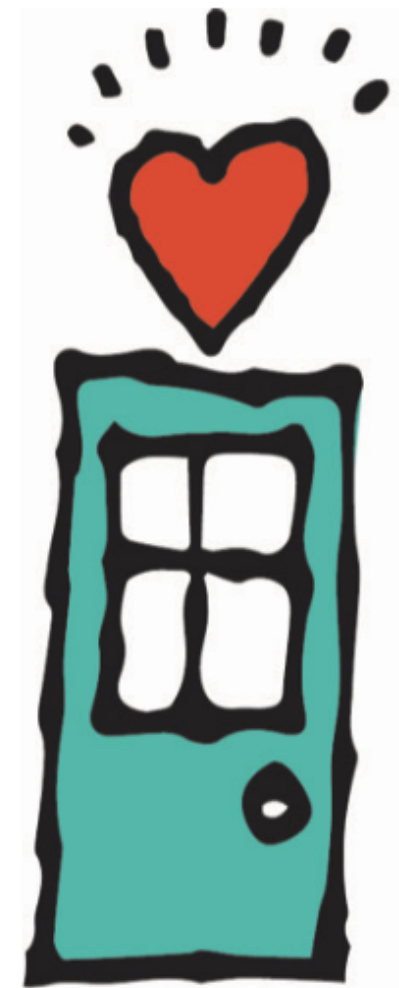
