How do you inspire community?

From providing emergency financial assistance, to families facing eviction, to helping teens find a safe and supportive environment outside of school hours, the work of the CRC has never been more important. Distinguished by our ability to be nimble and find ways to help people no matter what, the Community Resource Center of Stanwood Camano is a resource our neighbors can rely on.

When Mark lost his job during COVID, he wasn't sure how he was going to keep a roof over his family's head or food on the table. The Community Resource Center was able to help. The CRC provided emergency rental assistance for a brief time while Mark retrained for a new career. Once certified, the CRC was able to provide additional assistance to Mark, helping him secure the tools he'd need for his new trade. Mark credits the Community Resource Center with the stability his family has today.

This example is from the hundreds of people we've served in the past year. We know two things for sure. One is that this work wouldn't be possible without the support of generous community members like you, and two is that if we had more resources, we could do even more to help people in Stanwood and Camano Island as the needs of our community continue to evolve.

The CRC built on existing teen programs to meet the need for social and emotional well being in our local teen population serving a total of 150 different students.

1465 individuals were provided with basic necessities such as gas vouchers, propane, financial assistance for utilities and case management.

We have helped serve approximately 2000 individuals in the Stanwood Camano area during community events and programs that bring people together and provide connection, belonging, and opportunities for lifelong learning.



The CRC opened the 360 Learning Experience to improve Kindergarten Readiness in 0-5 year olds in the Stanwood Camano community. This program has seen impressive attendance numbers and has received extraordinary feedback from families.



CRC Volunteers donated over 1500 hours of volunteer time to essential functions of the CRC including operations, events, DD services, and board direction.
